For example in the Neuro section, they go into the grading of reflexes and spasticity (things that aren't necessarily that easy for me to remember). I actually bought an additional 4 as gifts for some friends in my program as a Christmas gift! I will definitely update my review when I get their input/opinions on this quick reference guide! So far however, I think its great and I am extremely happy with my purchase!
