


The book was found

When I looked through the Kindle First selections for September, I had a hard time choosing one because none of the choices really appealed to me. I can usually find one book that suits my contemporary romance/historical fiction/contemporary fiction interests but I had a difficult time this

month, so I decided to choose Who We Were Before by Leah Mercer. It seemed like the closest fit for me and, while it most closely fits into the contemporary fiction genre in my opinion, I have mixed feelings about this book and I'll explain why. Zoe and Edward Morgan have experienced the worst thing imaginable, losing a child they never thought they'd have. Prior to that, they were a happy couple with a good life: jobs, a house in the beautiful English countryside, and a great marriage. After a bit of a rocky start to their relationship, they have agreed to always be honest with each other...or so they think. After the tragic death of their son, Zoe is a shell of her former self and pretty much just moves through the motions, which is likely what most people in her situation would do. Zoe's parents send them on a trip to Paris to get away for a bit where they will end up learning about all of the things they have kept from each other and will have to decide if their love can endure everything they've been through. As I mentioned earlier, I have mixed feelings on this book. As a mother myself, I can't even begin to imagine losing a child and greatly empathized with Zoe and Edward. On the other hand, I had a hard time ignoring all of the secrets Zoe and Edward keep from each other and the lies that stem from them. After Zoe promises not to lie ever again, she continues to do it and the lies spiral out of control.
